HULL AND DECK STRUCTURE

- Structures are built in accordance with American Bureau of Shipping Guide for Building and Classing Offshore Yachts.
- Structures and stability are designed in accordance with the ISO standard (12217 and 1215-5), CE, Lloyds and ISAF regulations.
- Hull is laminated with vinylester resins using biaxial and double bias fabric.
- Closed cell foam core utilised in Hull and Deck construction.
- Exterior of Hull and Deck will be high gloss isophthalic white gel coat.
- GRP moulded main structural bulkhead, laminated on hull and deck for optimum stiffness.
- Deck is of foam core with double bias E-glass laminate in vinylester resin.
